Expression of Interest

To the Minister/Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports,

With this letter we would like to express the interest of The Future Learning Finland (FLF) Program and its members to start discussing concrete possibilities of cooperation with Romanian representatives. The envisaged cooperation would focus on creating a Master level teacher training program together with the assigned Romanian partner(s). This "Expression of Interest" is delivered to the Romanian representatives by the Embassy of Finland on behalf of Future Learning Finland and its members.

Future Learning Finland is a government backed program that was launched in January 2011 to provide Finnish educational solutions internationally, tailored to meet the needs of global customers. FLF brings together the top players from Finland with the best solutions, from private companies to educational and research institutions. Currently there are over 70 members actively participating in the program. FLF is coordinated by Finpro and powered by three Finnish government ministries: the Ministry of Education and Culture, the Ministry of Employment and the Economy and the Ministry for Foreign Affairs.

The program thus acts as the umbrella for Finnish education know-how and expertise, also being the contact point for possible projects abroad. Future Learning Finland can therefore assist in forming a group of expert organisations that will cooperate with Romanian partners. The agreements of cooperation will be made between the Romanian and the Finnish partners. Future Learning Finland does not sign agreements but rather acts only as the facilitating platform in the initial phase.

Proposal of partners from Finland

Future Learning Finland proposes that the role of Finnish partner in this project should be given to FCG – Finnish Consulting Group and Finnish Universities with Faculties of Educational Sciences. FCG would act as the coordinating organisation and the universities as the providers of educational expertise.


Request of information

At this stage, Future Learning Finland would be interested to know the following details from the Romanian representatives in order to proceed with building up a needed base of expertise from Finland. The information will be disseminated by FCG – Finnish Consulting Group and they will also form the group of Finnish experts that is necessary for efficient cooperation.

- The name of the Romanian partner(s) interested in cooperating with the Finnish side
- The areas of expertise that the Romanian partner(s) see as needed for the cooperation
- The names and titles of the key persons from the Romanian partner(s)
- The names and titles of the contact person(s) from the Romanian partner(s)

The above-mentioned details would be very important for Future Learning Finland, as they will open up the scope of the project and help us and FCG – Finnish Consulting Group in finding the suitable partners in Finland.
